NOTE: Gopher Tortoises are a protected species and can't be moved unless they are in imminent danger. If you've found a gopher tortoise in imminent danger, please relocate it to the nearest safe place and call us at 904-775-5569

Carefully place the turtle in a box. Use thick gloves, a shovel, or another method aside from your bare hands - especially if it's a snapping turtle or soft-shell turtle.

Bring it to a WRC dropoff location. If you are unable to get it to a dropoff location within 2 hours, please call us for further instructions.

KEEP IN MIND

Never place a turtle in a pond or other water source. If it is injured, it may not be able to swim and it will drown.

Wash your hands with soap after touching any turtle.

Don't attempt to feed the turtle anything, but DO offer a small dish of water.
